To capture their essence we have chosen old vines, cultivated in traditional Mediterranean gobelet with low yields, which produce concentrated and aromatic grapes.

We use lighter bottles to preserve our planet.

Authentic, eco-friendly and surprising wines.



CINSAULT

Cinsault originates from the South of France. Ours comes from low yield vines, which produce grapes with depth and concentration. This fruit-forward red wine is the ideal partner for Mediterannean cuisine.



Badass, ALICANTE

Born in the Languedoc in 1855, Alicante Bouschet was used to color local and foreign bad wines... rendering it undesirable. Yet, trained in traditional gobelet, it gives lovely fruit aromas with a hint of coffee.



Old Star, CARIGNAN NOIR

Carignan noir is one of the great Mediterranean grapes. To capture its essence, we limited yields by growing it on stony soil with traditional gobelet pruning. It gives rich dark fruit and spice notes with ample freshness.



Rare, CARIGNAN BLANC

Carignan blanc is a rare
Mediterranean grape, with only
250 hectares remaining.
We like it for its originality,
vivacity, floral aromas and long
finish.



New Star, ORGANIC ROSÉ

Rosé was the first wine ever made in history, on the shore of the Mediterranean. Our is fresh and fruit-forward. Enjoy it as an aperitif, with salads, sushi or barbecues, but most importantly with good friends.
